1. Aim

The aim of the Reporting to Parents Procedure is to set out the guidelines for parents to be informed of their child's learning. One of these measures is a formal report that meets Australian Curriculum Assessment Reporting Authority and Catholic Education system criteria and is provided twice a year.

At St Columba's Catholic Primary School, the Semester Reports are constructed to ACARA and CECWA requirements.

Procedures for Semester Reports

Parents and caregivers are notified of reporting dates via the school calendar and newsletter at the beginning of the school year.

The Semester Reports is distributed electronically via SEQTA Engage at the end of the nominated day. Reports are generally available on the last Thursday of Term Two or Term Four.

Where practicable and possible reports are sent to nominated email addresses for those children whose parents share custody.
